

Minor Research Projects and National Seminars

The institute plays a vital role in promoting research culture among the faculty members. The faculty members are encouraged to submit maximum number of research/seminar proposals to UGC for receiving grants. Till date college has been sanctioned 18 Minor Research Projects, 05 National Seminars and 01 State Level Seminar by UGC. 07 Minor Research Projects have been completed and submitted to UGC and work over 11 Minor Research Projects is under process. All the MRPs are concerned with social and environment issues. The findings prove to be beneficial for the community of the region. A part of the sanctioned amount of the MRP is allocated for books and equipments and as a result, it helps in enriching the library and concerned departments/laboratories. In order to complete the research work lecturers have to organize survey, interview, and questionnaire and this helps in increasing their knowledge and interactive power and thereby it enhances their competence level with comparison to other institutions and agencies.

We have conducted the following National Seminars during the last four years-

1. The Department of History conducted a National Seminar on the topic “Recent Economic Depression: Capitalism & Road Ahead” on 20-21 Feb. 2010.
2. The Department of Hindi conducted a National Seminar on the topic “Uchha Shiksha Me Pathyakrama Nirman Evam Pariksha Ankan Padhati Me Sudhar Ki Gunjais ” on 04-05 Feb. 2012.
3. The Department of English conducted a National Seminar on the topic “Development of Communication Skills among the Under-privileged Students of the Rural Colleges” on 01-02 Feb. 2014.

The proceedings of the UGC sponsored National Seminar conducted by the Department of Hindi have been published with ISBN number and the publication of the proceedings of another UGC sponsored National Seminar conducted by Department of English has also been published under ISBN number. During the last four year as many as 17 research papers of various faculty members have been published in Seminar proceedings and Journals.
